The Palm Island estate that used to belong to record producer Scott Storch—and Rockstar energy drink founder Russ Weiner before him—has seven bedrooms, 12 bathrooms and sizes up at just under 20,000 square feet. Co-listed by Brett Harris of Douglas Elliman and Alex Daguer of Fortune International Realty, Birdman's pad also

has two wine cellars, a summer kitchen with a pizza oven, a home theater, a volleyball court, and a pool overlooking the bay.
